Guidance for Attendees

Before the Singing Day

Do not come to the Singing Day if:

- you have symptoms / feel unwell
- you have tested positive (PCR or Lateral flow)
- you have been told to self-isolate
- someone you have close contact with has tested positive
- you are quarantining after a visit abroad

We encourage you to use lateral flow tests regularly (ideally on the day of the Singing Day if you can)

We encourage you to get vaccinated

The venue will be cleaned before the Singing Day / after the last use

During the Singing Day

Maintain 1m social distancing at all times (we are only using every other pew)

Be respectful of each other's space

Stand/sit side by side in your sections

Wear a face mask indoors when not rehearsing, unless exempt

We will keep doors and windows open - consider bringing warm clothing

Wash / sanitise your hands on arrival and regularly after that

Follow any protocols the venue has in place

Check in the venue's test and trace procedures using NHS app (optional)

Sign in to our register

Avoid touching shared surfaces as much as possible

Bring your own music unless hired in advance. Do not share equipment if possible (use hand sanitiser if you do)

Bring your own refreshments
